A few words on the importance of becoming a Director

The benefits that you receive as a Chamber member are in part the direct result of people just like you – Medford business owners, managers – all of whom willingly volunteer their time as members of the Board of Directors.

Each year, we look for eight (8) good people to volunteer their time as Directors.

As a member on the Chamber Board of Directors, you will participate in shaping the future of the Chamber through your vote, your ideas, your experience, and your expertise. Your term of office is three years, at the conclusion of which, if you wish, you may run for the position again.

The Board meets monthly, usually on the first Wednesday. You are expected to attend these informative, interesting, and often exciting Board meetings, and to participate on at least one committee. After one year on the Board, you are eligible for nomination as President-elect, if that is your goal.

(Some of our committees include: Newsletter, Finance, Bylaws, Programs, Fundraising, Scholarship, Citizen of the Year, Antique Auto Show, Clipper Ship Day, Halloween Trick-or-Treat, Victorian Stroll, Pancake Breakfast, Holiday/Christmas Events, and Annual Banquet.)
