**Jared Carrabis** is a 20-year-old baseball enthusiast who, at 18-years-old, penned his first book, *One Fan's Story: If This Hat Could Talk*. The 352-page book tells the tale of how at 16, Carrabis used social media as a fast track to the Red Sox organization. In January of 2006, Carrabis created SoxSpace, which at the time was just an online community for Red Sox fans to gather and read Carrabis' writing. That online community quickly grew to 90,000 strong. Not long after, a snowball effect would result in much, much more for the Boston native.

Carrabis finished third in the first running for President of Red Sox Nation to the legendary Jerry Remy in 2007. In 2008, Carrabis was elected as the first ever Governor of Red Sox Nation for his home state of Massachusetts. In 2009, just months before the release of his debut book, SoxSpace took home an award for "Best Red Sox Blog" at the New England Sports Blog awards, and was also nominated for "Best Boston Sports Blog."

In 2010, Carrabis began his new Red Sox endeavor by becoming the host of the TruFan Red Sox Webcast, which is filmed and broadcast live from Boston, MA on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2-3pm EST on TruFan.com/Webcast. The Webcast is viewed by close to 40,000 Red Sox fans from all over the world each and every episode.

As of today, his debut book has sold at least one copy in 39 of the 50 American states and in four different countries in the world, proving once again that it really is Red Sox *Nation*.
